

Message from Principal




Dear children

Things to do during the Summer Break

1. Build Vocabulary- Today's readers are tomorrow's leaders.

- a) Read out a story from the Story Book every day to your child
- b) Help your child picture read a story to you every day.
- c) Encourage your child to read and encircle sight words, such as I, am, my, you, the, to, is, for etc. in the newspaper, old magazines or books.
- d) Tag and display sight words in your home, as we do in the class e.g. on a chair paste a paper with chair written on it, so that the child often reads it. Similarly, you can tag door, table, bed, cupboard, dustbin etc.
- 2. I am responsible- Help your child to be independent by allowing him / her doing the following:
 - a) Buttoning and unbuttoning the shirt.
 - b) Learning to wear shoes and socks.
 - c) Laying the table
 - d) Clearing the work area after the activity.
 - e) Folding clothes.
 - f) Watering plants.
- 3. Physical and emotional well-being.
 - a) These are times like no others. The children would have usually gone for the trips to their relatives houses or on a vacation. So please talk to your child and show pictures of different places and monuments, arranging for a virtual trip.
 - b) Play indoor and outdoor games like bingo, word-ladder, hopscotch, bounce the ball, catch the ball, ludo etc.
 - c) Physical exercises should be done every day.
- 4. Rhyme time.


- a) Learn all the rhymes that have been done in the class.

- 7. Click pictures of all the activities (mentioned in the holidays home work) done by your child and make a collage on your mobile phone. You can share it on whatsapp.










- Water is a home to many animals in the form of sea.




Activity 4 Outdoor activity- nature shapes

c) Collect flowers, put them in a string, and enjoy the garland.




d) Be creative and enjoy the magic.

- Things required:
- 1.Brown colour sheet/Scrap file
- 2.Black sketch pen
- 3.Bangle (to make lion face)
- 4.Orange water colour
- 5.Fork

- Step1-Take a bangle/round object to make a circle with the black sketch pen
- Step 2-Paste (googly eyes) or draw lion eyes, nose and moustaches with black sketch pen to complete a lion's face as shown.

Step3- Dip a fork into orange paint and go around the outside of the circle.
